that the materials, preparations and products supplied by us contain no substances from the current valid candidate list according to Article 59 (1.10) of directive (EC) No.1907/2006 in excess of 0.1 % mass. Otherwise, we shall notify Aug. Winkhaus GmbH & Co.KG immediately in writing.

Since 27.06.2018, metallic lead has also been listed in the SVHC (Substances of Very High Concern) candidate list of the REACH directive, passed unanimously by the member states on 12 June 2018.

This has direct impacts on manufactured products: According to Article 33 of the REACH directive, from the point that lead was added to the SVHC candidate list, communication obligations in the supply chain apply when the concentration limit of 0.1 % is exceeded in products. Manufacturers and suppliers of products (e.g. semi-finished products, components, machines, electrical goods etc.) must inform their commercial customers if lead is present in a concentration of over 0.1 % in the smallest subassembly. For machines, in concrete terms, this means that every tiny component of the assembled product is used as a reference value for the calculation.

We promise to carry out all necessary measures to ensure that Aug. Winkhaus GmbH & Co. KG can continue to be supplied with the known substances, preparations and products in the future.

We will inform you immediately if the delivery availability is at risk as a result of REACH.

We are aware that we are liable for compensation if we cannot fulfil our existing delivery obligations to Aug. Winkhaus GmbH & Co. KG.
